In selling retail as such to permit holders having authority to purchase and use intoxicating liquor for nonbeverage purposes Article XVI, Regulations 2 & T.D.19. In filling prescriptions on Form 1403, according to Article XVI, Regulations 2.

AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION FORM 1404, IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS 11.

The maximum quantity of spirituous and vinous liquors which may be possessed by the applicant at any one time shall be the quantity necessary to meet the legitimate needs of the applicant for all operations under such permit, but not to exceed 7 wine gallons of alcohol; 6 wine gallons of whiskey; 2 wine gallons of other distilled spirits; and 15 wine gallons of wine and alcoholic preparations fit for beverage purposes.
